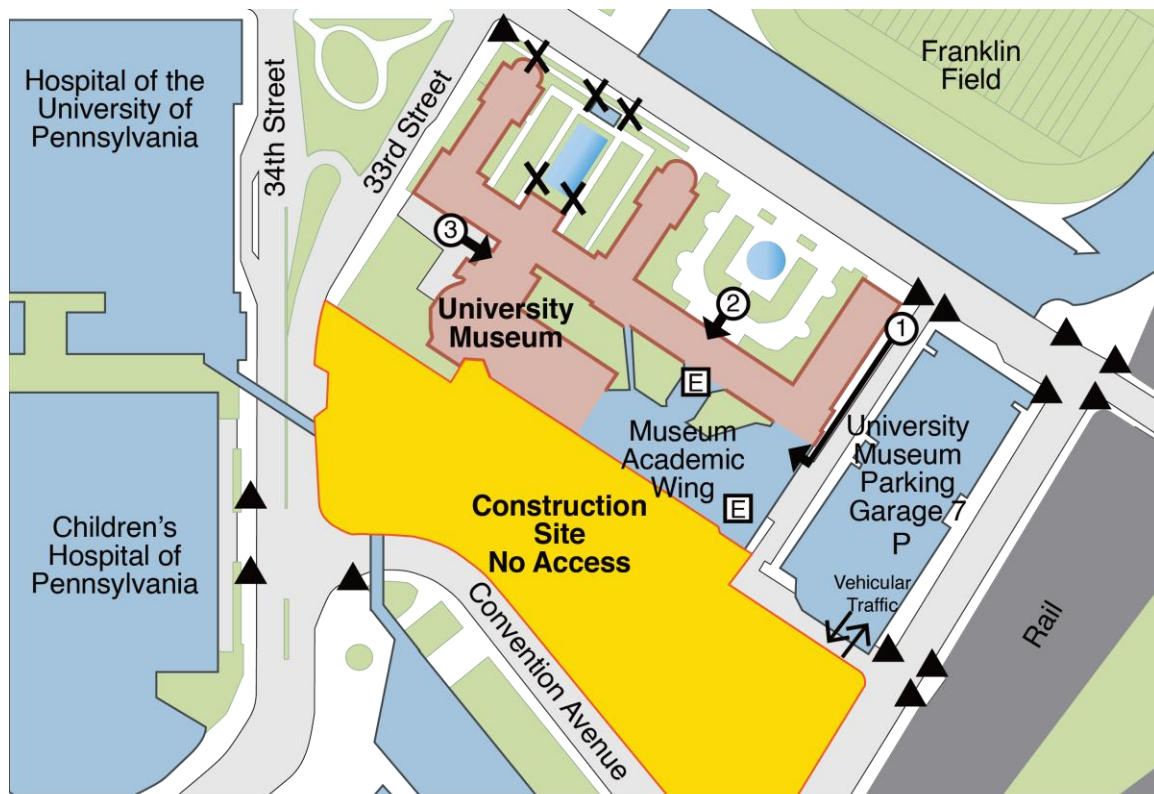

Entrance Information:

3260 South Street. Philadelphia. PA. 19104

1. The Kress Wing Entrance of the University Museum Academic Wing provides level passage to the University Museum on the first floor. The entrance is located on the southeast side of the building across from the University Museum Parking Garage. There are curb cuts and automatic doors leading to the University Museum Academic Wing lobby. There is a guard in the lobby during all open hours.
2. There is an entrance to the Museum through the Stoner Courtyard, which is the eastern of the two courtyards opening onto South Street. The ground slopes gently up from street level to the doors, one of which is equipped with a push-pad.
3. The northwest entrance off Lot 46 is a level entrance to the Harrison Auditorium only. The University Museum and restrooms are not accessible from this entrance.

- All other entrances to the University Museum have steps.

Elevator Information:

- There is a bank of two elevators on the eastern side of the inner courtyard.
- There is a second bank of two elevators located in the Museum Academic Wing. There are level passages from all floors of the Museum Academic Wing into the Museum.

- On the third floor in the Greek Gallery there is a raised gallery exhibiting Greek artifacts. There is a lift to the gallery, which requires a museum staff person to operate. There is a button beside the lift, which will call a staff person to assist you.
- The Lower Egyptian Gallery has stairs to it but can be accessed by the freight elevator in the University Museum Academic Wing. Contact the guard at the Kress Wing Entrance (Entrance #1) to use this elevator.
- There is an oversized elevator located in the Manwaring Wing used both for accessibility and moving the collection.

Accessible Restrooms:

- First floor of the University Museum Academic Wing - men's and women's.
- All restrooms in the Manwaring Wing are accessible.

Building Information:

- The University Museum is directly connected to the University Museum Academic Wing by passages on the first, second and third floors.
- The Manwaring Wing is connected to the rest of the Museum on two levels.
- The Harrison Auditorium is sloped with accessible seating in the rear. Use Entrance #3 to enter.
- The Stoner Courtyard and garden is level and fully accessible.
- The museum shop is accessible.
